Historical garden seeds collected and shared by the Heirloom Seed Project are part of the rich variety of Pennsylvania German material culture collected and preserved by the Landis Valley Museum. Our founders, George and Henry Landis, saw that modern life was changing traditional ways of doing things and they set out to preserve all kinds of artifacts. The collection includes implements of cultivation such as early trowels, dibbles, mattocks and hoes. Old glass jars and cloth bags for storage attest to the thriftiness of seed savers from past generations. The Heirloom Seed project enhances the heritage and information preserved in the collection at Landis Valley Museum.

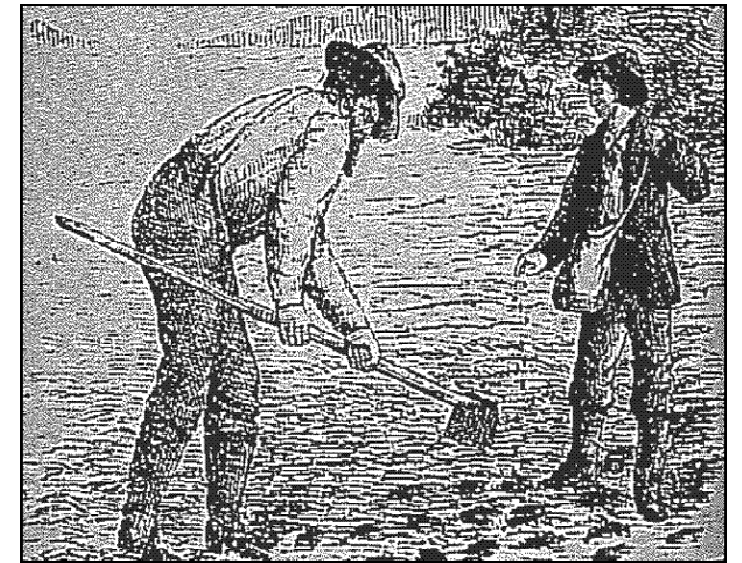
