



Yellow Barn and Courtyard

The Yellow Barn was built in 1939 with timber framing from the earlier 1814 Brick Farmstead barn. This historic building was the first one George & Henry Landis used to house their museum exhibits.

With a capacity of 225 people in 2,800 sq. ft., the Yellow Barn is perfect for wedding receptions, family reunions, dances, socials or any other event you can imagine. It is beautifully decorated with hundreds of white twinkle lights laced around the wooden columns and draped across the ceiling beams giving it a warm and elegant glow. Just imagine arriving at this scene in a horse-drawn carriage! What a memorable experience!

The rental of the Yellow Barn includes 2 large covered implement sheds that are ideal for your buffet. You also get a beautiful outdoor 3,500 sq. ft. courtyard. This is a perfect for your ceremony and cocktail reception.

Heated in the winter, the barn is available year-round for events from 5:00 pm to 11:00 pm.

Receptacle Information:

Inside the Yellow Barn: Includes heat and ceiling fans, no AC:

North left side (facing courtyard): First two receptacles on one circuit, 20 amps; second two receptacles on one circuit, 20 amps

Middle pole: separate circuit, 20 amps

South right side: three receptacles on one circuit, 20 amps

Yellow Barn Sheds and Courtyard:

North Shed (total of 60 amps): one receptacle by small doorway, closest to the barn, 20 amps; two double receptacles on far side, 20 amps each, (40 amps total).

South Shed (20 amps total): one receptacle at end near gun shop, 20 amps.
