

HEIRLOOM SEED PROJECT

Established more than thirty years ago at Landis Valley Village & Farm Museum, the Heirloom Seed Project focuses on seed preservation, growing heirloom varieties of vegetables that have historical significance for Pennsylvania Germans from 1750 to 1940.

The Heirloom Seed Project is staffed primarily by volunteers who tend the gardens and preserve and package the heirloom seeds. Our vegetables are grown without the use of pesticides.

Heirloom or open-pollinated fruit brings our history into the present with flavors and beauty from the past. Gardeners can save seeds from heirloom varieties with the assurance that the fruit from each new generation of plants will bear fruit that is like the fruit from past seasons.

2019 Notes

We have a limited supply of Dr. Martin Lima Bean seed because of two successive seasons with too much rain. You may want to save your own seed in 2019 if your climate produces a good crop of beans.

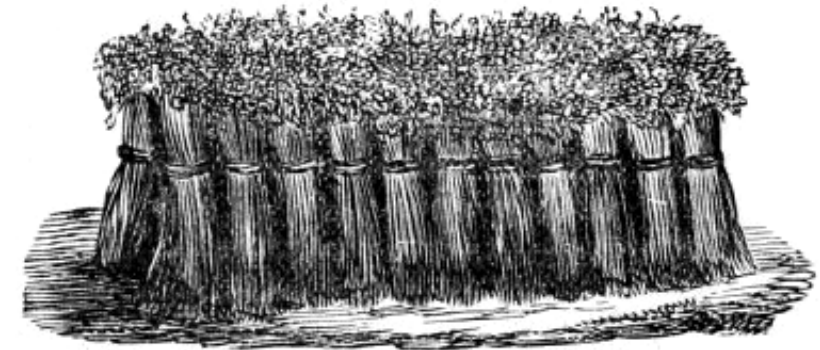


Fig. 10.—STOOK OF FLAX.
